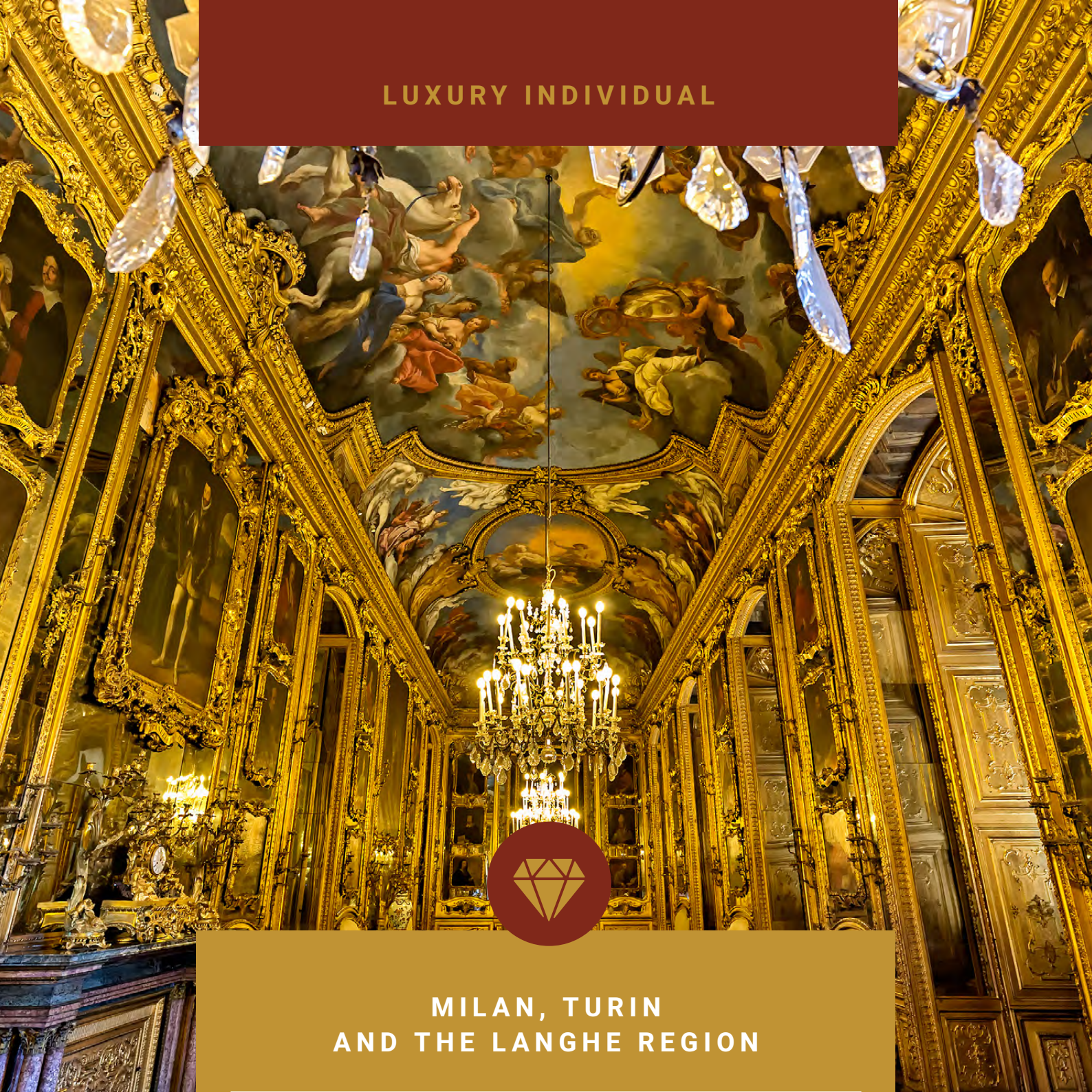

## Itinerary

### DAY 1 | ARRIVAL · MILAN

Arrival at Milan Malpensa Airport and meet & greet with your personal concierge and driver. Transfer to the hotel in Milan.

Check-in at the hotel.

In the afternoon, guided tour of Brera district and then the Quadrilatero d'Oro, Milan fashion quarter.

Later, panoramic private tour of Milan by historical tram.

### DAY 2 | MILAN · TURIN

In the morning visit the famous Leonardo Da Vinci "Last Supper".

Visit Prada Foundation, an exhibition space dedicated to contemporary art and culture.

Tasting at one of Italy's most renowned gastronomic establishments, Peck, famously known as the "food temple".

In the afternoon, departure for Turin.

Check-in at the hotel.

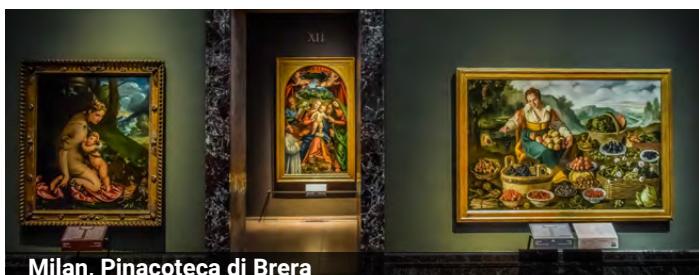
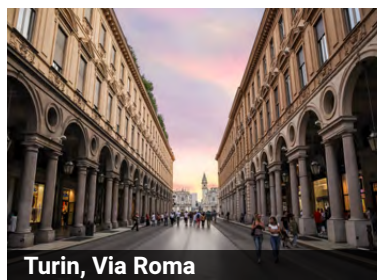
### DAY 3 | TURIN

In the morning guided tour of the city center: Turin Cathedral with the Chapel of the Holy Shroud, the Royal Church of San Lorenzo, and the magnificent Palazzo Reale. During the visit, we'll take a break for a coffee in Piazza San Carlo, in one of the famous historical Café of the city. Then continue to the Mole Antonelliana, hosting the National Museum of Cinema. End the tour with a sweet treat in a confectioner's shop in Piazza Vittorio Veneto.

In the afternoon we will visit the Egyptian Museum, one of the most important in the world after the one in Cairo. Before dinner, we will visit a Vermouth factory, where you'll learn about the production of famous Vermouth 'Anselmo' and enjoy a tasting.

### DAY 4 | TURIN

In the morning visit of the Reggia di Venaria, which was restored to its original splendor thanks to the largest conservation project in Europe and has been declared a World Heritage Site for Humanity by UNESCO.

In the afternoon visit the Castello di Rivoli, built in the XVII century on what remained from a former fortress.

### DAY 5 | TURIN · ALBA

Departure to Alba. On the way, visit to the Abbazia di Staffarda, imposing Romanesque-style complex located at the feet of the Monviso.

Proceed to Grinzane Cavour, free lunch (not included) at the Castle.

In the afternoon visit the winery and Castle museum; it is considered one of the oldest and the most imposing castles in the Langhe.

Proceed to Neive, which was recently voted as one of the most beautiful Borghi in Italy and it's easy to see why... if you can drag yourself away from the jaw-dropping views which surround the town in all directions, you'll see a historical centre that dates back to 1000 AD, filled with elegant palazzi, churches and a magnificent medieval clock tower.

Visit Cantina del Glicine, a small, traditional winery with a remarkable surprise: its ancient cellars (or an alternative winery).

Proceed to Alba.

Check-in at the hotel.

### DAY 6 | ALBA

This morning we will walk through Alba (or transfer by private vehicle, according to accommodation location) and we will immerse into the Truffle Fair (from mid October to mid December - date to be reconfirmed).

In the afternoon a fun and interesting wine lesson that will surprise you. An expert will help you understand and feel the different characteristics of the wine, through several sensorial games, which will help to discover and experience the distinctive characteristics of various wines combined with their history and the connection with this beautiful land.

Return to the hotel in the late afternoon.

### DAY 7 | ALBA · LA MORRA POLLENZO · ALBA

In the morning departure to La Morra, considered the "balcony of the Langhe". Visit to Gian Piero Marrone winery (or an alternative winery) and wine tasting.

Proceed to Pollenzo, lunch at leisure (not included).

Visit to the wine bank, a collection of the best productions in Italy, including almost 100,000 bottles.

Return to the hotel in the afternoon.

### DAY 8 | ALBA · CASALE MONFERRATO · MILAN

Departure to Monferrato area. First stop is in Cella Monte, nice tiny village situated in the heart of the hilly countryside of Lower Monferrato.

Visit an "infernot" and to the Ecomuseum of Stonework. Proceed to Valcerrina valley, reach the tiny hamlet of Varengo in the townland of Gabiano, where the main attraction is the Church of San Eusebio.

Lunch in an historic mansion (according to availability).

The afternoon is devoted to the visit of Casale Monferrato. The Palaeologus dynasty ruled Monferrato from here before it came under the control of the Mantua-based Gonzaga family. The tour includes a visit to the Cathedral of Saint Evasio, the Church of Saint Michael, the Synagogue, one of the most noteworthy examples of a Baroque Synagogue in Piedmont, and the noble Palazzo Gozzani Treville, built in 1711.

Proceed to Milan.

Check-in at the hotel.

### DAY 9 | MILAN · DEPARTURE

Transfer to the airport with your private driver.
